Word. Read Luke 10:1-11 and 16-23

Why did he send out the disciples two by two?

How is the Christian like a “worker in the harvest”? or a “lamb among wolves”?

What was the purpose of travelling light? Of praying first, going later?

What kind of household guests were they to be and why?

How are they to relate to the town which they visit? And what is their basic message?

How do verses 1-12 show the urgency Jesus himself senses about evangelism? And what is the reason for this urgency?

Upon their return what does Jesus say to them? What in their report gives Jesus reason for joy?

Consider verse 23. Do you think the disciples appreciate the privilege of being with Jesus? Why or why not?

Worship. Arrange to do your own thing but also spend time praying for the outreach of our church and all the contact people at St Mary’s has with our community. Pray for the Christian witness of the other churches in Strensall.

Witness . How do you go about the harvest where you live?

Are people ripe for the gospel? What would it take for you to be more involved in the harvest?

When have you felt like “a lamb amongst wolves”? What did you learn from the experience?

What do these verses show you about the privileges we have in Jesus?
